**CERTIFICATION OF ELECTRONIC EVIDENCE
PURSUANT TO FEDERAL RULE OF EVIDENCE 902(13)**

1. Declarant Identification

2. Foundation Statement

I, Sarah Mitchell, Esq., am Senior Partner at Mitchell & Associates. I am a custodian of records and/or a qualified person familiar with the record-keeping system used to store and manage the electronic evidence identified in this certification. I have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein and am competent to testify to the same.

3. System Description

Attested is an electronic evidence management system operated by Verifore Technologies LLC. The system processes uploaded files as follows:

1. Computes a SHA-256 cryptographic hash of the file at time of upload
2. Stores the hash and file metadata in a PostgreSQL database
3. Stores the file in AES-256 encrypted cloud storage with TLS 1.2+ transit encryption
4. Records every access event (viewer identity, timestamp, IP address, action) in an immutable log
5. Displays viewer identity as a visible overlay during playback via viewer attribution watermarking

This process executes automatically without manual intervention.

4. Accuracy Statement

The electronic process described above produces accurate results. SHA-256 is a cryptographic hash function standardized by the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST FIPS 180-4). The probability of two distinct files producing an identical SHA-256 hash is approximately 1 in 2^{256} , rendering accidental collision computationally infeasible.

The system stores the hash value computed at upload and compares it against the current file to verify integrity. A matching hash confirms the file has not been altered since upload. All timestamps are recorded in UTC synchronized via NTP. Access logs are append-only and cannot be modified after creation.
